We are searching for partners for collaboration in the “Theatraquarium” project. We will submit the project to the 2015 Call for proposals of the Creative Europe Cultural cooperation projects program - Category 1. Project concept

The project will develop new performance practices based in the field of Devised Theatre Performance.

Methodologically, the productions will merge the fields of theatre, video and social media, illustrate and map diversity of different national mentalities as they pertain to this particular art form and use this new artistic form as a platform for theatre audience building activities for youth in age group 14 – 25 years.

The project foresees a collaboration of three partner institutions from the field of theatre. Using the same baseline inputs, each will produce their own theatre production and contribute the findings to the integrative stage of the project.

Key project activities

- » Production of 3 national Devised Theatre Performances
- » Production of 1 international Devised Theatre Performance
- » International Symposium on Devised Theatre Performance
- » Audience building activities

Project partner responsibilities

- » Selection of participating artists (5 emerging actors)
- » Selection of 5 spectators from the target age group
- » Selection of 1 professional advisor (mentor to the participating artists)
- » Production of 1 national Devised Theatre Performance
- » Communication activities (Symposium)
- » Audience building activities (Symposium, Social Networks)

Project goals

- » To enable cultural and creative players to collaborate internationally and to internationalize their careers and activities
- » To support international touring, events, exhibitions and festival
- » To test innovative approaches to audience development

Partnership structure

- » Ljubljana City Theatre (SI)
- » European Theatre Houses (2 – 3 organisations)

Project financing

The organiser wishes to submit the project for co-financing in the scope of the EU Creative Europe program/Co-operation projects/ Small scale cooperation projects. The application deadline is first week of October 2015. The earliest project start date is May 1, 2016. The organiser envisages 24 months as the project duration. The rate of grant co-financing is 60%.

About Ljubljana City Theatre

The Ljubljana City Theatre (Mestno gledališče ljubljansko – MGL) is the second largest Slovenian theatre. Established in 1951, its programme is presently oriented towards a production of contemporary theatre work as well as innovative directorial interpretation of classical pieces. The theatre company holds a predominantly young ensemble of thirty-eight actors and produces ten to twelve opening nights per season. The 2015/2016 repertoire includes work by David Greig, Henrik Ibsen, Ivan Vrypayev, Marius von Mayenburg, Ingmar Bergman, Tena Štivičić and contemporary Slovenian authors, such as Simona Semenič. The theatre is situated in the centre of the Slovenian capital Ljubljana and holds the largest permanent audience base of all Slovenian theatre institutions.
